

ALTERNATE/ADDITIONAL MEETINGS:

1. Drug-Free Workplace (To include both Supervisory and Employee Training Sessions; ALL EMPLOYEES)
2. Safe Driving Techniques/Preventing Distracted Driving Incidents (ALL EMPLOYEES)
3. Hostile Work Environment (Sexual Harassment, including a review of regulations and policies; ALL EMPLOYEES)
4. Violence in the Workplace (Dealing with irate or dangerous customers or coworkers);
5. Accident/Incident Reporting and Procedures (A review of procedures and concerns for employees involved in an accident or incident – will refer to the utility's in-place forms and procedures if available; will address report completion and documentation; ALL EMPLOYEES)
6. Hazard Recognition, Documentation, and Reporting (Will address observation, reporting, and correcting hazards recognized in the field or workplace, and conducting and tracking correction of observed or reported hazards; OPERATIONS)
